Rule Statement

The West Texas A&M University (WTAMU) campus is a smoke-free and vape-free campus. The use of all tobacco products (e.g. cigarettes, cigars, snuff, and tobacco dip and chew), including smokeless tobacco products (e.g. vape pens, e-cigarettes and hookahs), legal and illegal smoking products is prohibited at all University property, facility and/or state vehicle. Rules governing the use of these products in the residence halls can be found in the Code of Student Life Handbook.

Procedures and Responsibilities

No tobacco, including smokeless tobacco products (e.g. vape pens and hookahs), legal and illegal smoking products will be allowed in or on the University property. This will include the use of these products in personal vehicles while on campus.

By establishing a smoke and vape-free campus, WTAMU continues to put the health and safety of its campus community and visitors first.
