Basic steps for using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool

- ✤ <u>www.fafsa.gov</u>
  - Log in to your 18/19 FAFSA record
  - Make FAFSA corrections
  - Navigate to financial information section and follow instructions to determine if you are eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.
  - If eligible, transfer 2016 IRS income tax information into your FAFSA
- A 2016 IRS Tax Return Transcript may be obtained through:
  - Get Transcript by <u>MAIL</u> Go to <u>www.irs.gov</u>, under the Tools heading, click "Get a tax transcript." Click "Get Transcript by MAIL." Make sure to request the "IRS Tax Return Transcript" and **NOT** the "IRS Tax Account Transcript."
  - Get Transcript by <u>ONLINE</u> Go to <u>www.irs.gov</u>, under the Tools heading, click "Get a tax transcript." Click "Get Transcript ONLINE." Make sure to request the "IRS Tax Return Transcript" and **NOT** the "IRS Tax Account Transcript."

A 2016 IRS Non-Filing Tax Transcript may be obtained through:

- Get Transcript by Mail Download form 4506-T from <u>www.irs.gov</u>, mail or fax the completed form to the appropriate address (or fax number) at the IRS. Make sure to check box 7 for 'Verification of Non-filing' After the IRS receives and processes the signed request the Non-Filing letter will be mailed within 5 to 10 business days.
- Get Transcript <u>ONLINE</u> Go to <u>www.irs.gov</u>, under the Tools heading, click "Get a tax transcript." Click "Get Transcript ONLINE." After logging in select the appropriate 2016 tax year and select form *Verification of Non-Filing*.

When you receive the IRS tax return transcript, please submit it to WTAMU Financial Aid with your Buff ID number included on each page of the report.
