Once had committee make comparison of WT to equivalent institutions and sent data with justification to legislature, got large raise. (Under Long and Killebrew, so long ago.)

Put numbers before those who can change it. Something needs to be done-have full-time (tenured) faculty looking for second jobs. Amarillo College pays more than WTAMU.

Faculty don't feel supported, as those who deal directly with students.

Add discuss technology with President: computers are inadequate, difficulty in getting apps needed for research. Not able to get clearance from IT to load needed software. People to handle software.
