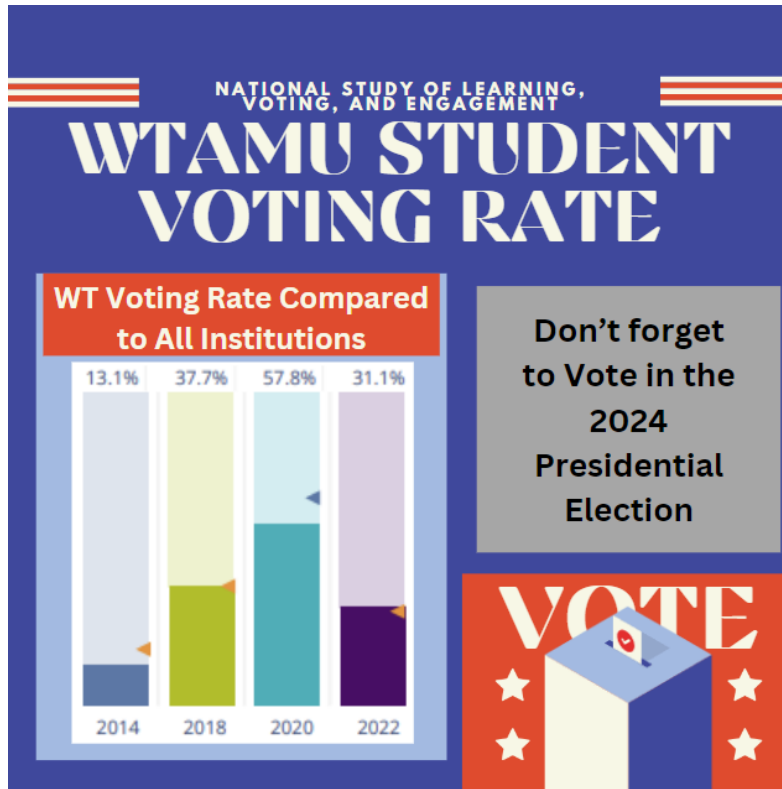


**Data Bite # 5 - Voting**



**WTAMU Voting Rate**

The National Study of Learning, Voting, and Engagement (NSLVE) produces a report that focuses on the voting rate, breakdown, and method of higher education students.

When looking at the overall voting rate of WT students vs. the overall average, WT students have historically ranked below average, except in the 2022 election, where they ranked slightly ahead at 31.1%.
