

## SHELTER-IN-PLACE

## **DURING SEVERE WEATHER/ENVIRONMENTAL DANGER**

Shelter-in-place events are usually weather related emergencies. When it is necessary to shelter-inplace, you will be safest by moving to an inside space.

- 1. Immediately seek shelter inside the closest sturdy building. Do not lock doors behind you in case others also need to seek shelter.
- 2. Go to the bottom floor of the building, seek shelter in basements, interior rooms and corridors. Do not use elevators.
- 3. Avoid large, free-standing expanses, such as auditoriums. Stay away from windows and objects that may fall.
- 4. If caught outdoors or in a vehicle, abandon the vehicle and seek shelter in the nearest sturdy building. If no building is available, find a low spot or ditch and lay down.
- 5. Await further instruction from Buff Alerts and emergency personnel.
- 6. Do not leave until an "All Clear" is received.
