

Administration of the Master's Comprehensive Exam

The four hour master's comprehensive exam is administered through WTClass in an online proctored environment.

The following rules apply:

- 1. The exam is located in a Bb course in WTClass titled EDLD Program Summative Assessment. If this course does not appear in the candidate's list of Bb courses in WTClass at least one week prior to the exam, the candidate should notify Dr. Barbosa at rbarbosa@wtamu.edu.
- 2. A password will be provided by the test proctor enabling the candidate(s) to access the exam.
- 3. No outside materials, including access to online resources, are allowed during the exam.
- 4. Exam results (pass/fail) will be reported to the candidate via email within two weeks of the exam date.

Online Proctored Exam

The online exam will be proctored by Examity®. This service allows flexibility to schedule exams at the candidate's convenience and take the wherever candidate desires as long as the exam rules are strictly observed.
