↻ To gain admittance to the College of Business, students must successfully complete pre-business core courses with a grade of "C" or higher. Students seeking admission that have completed 48 or more credit hours in a different major or as a transfer student may be admitted to the business program with approval by dean or associate dean. (See catalog or Pre-Business checklist for more details.)

♦ A minimum of 42 hours from the core curriculum is required. Some majors specify particular courses to meet core-curriculum requirements when options are available. Ideally, these courses should be taken during the first two years of enrollment.

PB Pre-business requirements are: ACCT 2301; ECON 2301; ECON 2302; MATH 1325 or MATH 2413 (or equivalent); BUSI 1304, CIDM 1301, CIDM 1315, CIDM 2345 or FIN 1307 (or advisor approved Core 90 equivalent); ENGL 1302 or COMM 1321 (or advisor approved equivalent).

NOTE: At least 39 hours of advanced work (3000- or 4000-level courses) for which tuition is paid must be earned at WTAMU, and 30 of the final 36 hours counted toward the degree must be earned at WTAMU. A maximum of six semester hours in religion (RELI) and six semester hours in physical education (PHED) courses can count toward a baccalaureate degree.

Note: This is NOT a degree plan. After completing 30 hours, students are encouraged to request an official degree plan in the office of the dean of the College of Business, located in the Classroom Center, Room 216 (or call 806-651-2526). Students who have completed 45 hours will not be allowed to progress without requesting a degree plan.
