ADDITIONAL NOTES:

BBA/MPA is the same as BBA, except 6 hrs. of 3000/4000 level accounting electives are taken at the graduate level. The graduate portion of the combined BBA/MPA consists of 27 hours of graduate accounting courses (some specified, some elective)

and 9 hours of additional graduate courses by advisement. See BBA/MPA Coordinator for specifics. Total 150 Hours.
