CAVEAT: This course sequence is based on course descriptions in the University catalog, the two-year course rotation, and the spring and fall schedules of classes; it is subject to change.

NOTES:

FOUNDATION CORE is the goal during the freshman year for an art major:

- ARTS 1311 (two-dimensional design) and ARTS 1316 (drawing I) plus one of the art history courses (1303 or 1304) in the fall semester.
- ARTS 1312 (three-dimensional design) and ARTS 1317 (drawing II) plus one of the art history courses in the spring semester.
- ARTS 1303 and 1304 do NOT have to be taken in sequence. If developmental courses are needed, ARTS 1303/1304 can be delayed.

¹ARTS 1312: prerequisite is ARTS 1311

²ARTS 1317: prerequisite is ARTS 1316

³ **INTERMEDIATE CORE** is the goal for the sophomore year:

- Completion of the FOUNDATION CORE (ARTS 1311, 1312, 1316, 1317, 1303, 1304) is the prerequisite for all INTERMEDIATE CORE courses.
- Transfer students who do not have the foundation core completed must see an instructor of an intermediate core course to get blue-carded into the course.
- Take one course in each of the following three areas:
 - ARTS 2316 (Painting I, fall/spring) or ARTS 2366 (Watermedia I, spring)
 - ARTS 2346 (Ceramics I, fall/spring) or ARTS 2375 (Glass I, fall/spring)
 - ARTS 2313 (Graphic Design I, fall) or ARTS 2377 (Computer Art I, fall/spring)

⁴ The catalog lists 18 hours of business courses: ACCT 2301, ACCT 2302 (Prereq. ACCT 2301), BUSI 1301, MGT 3330, MKT 3340, MGT 3332 (Prereq. MGT 3330, MKT 3340, FIN 3320 [Prereq. ACCT 2301, ACCT 2302 or concurrent enrollment, CIDM 2342 or concurrent enrollment]). [BUSI 1301 has not been offered in five years and may never again be offered.] Contact the ATD department for suggestions.

⁵ **Advanced art elective:** a course at the 3000 or 4000 level for which prerequisites have already been met, but ARTS 4371 (art history), for example, does not have art prerequisites.

* 39 hours of advanced (3000- and 4000-level) coursework is required for the degree.
