ENSEMBLE REQUIREMENT: A minimum of eight fall or spring semesters of major ensemble are required for bachelor of music (B.M.) degrees. Band (MUEN XX26 or XX27) is the major ensemble for woodwinds, brass, and percussion; choir (MUEN XX41 or XX42) for voice; orchestra (MUEN XX29) for strings; choir for keyboard majors, but keyboard students may choose band or orchestra, respectively, if they can play a woodwind, brass, percussion, or string instrument.

*** While MATH 1332, 1342 and 1350 will fulfill core math requirements, they will NOT prepare students for higher-level math courses such as Plane Trigonometry (MATH 1316) or Pre-Calculus (MATH 2412).

***** Course numbers vary depending on lesson or ensemble taken.

NOTE: At least 39 hours of advanced work (3000- or 4000-level courses) for which tuition is paid must be earned at WTAMU, and 30 of the final 36 hours counted toward the degree must be earned at WTAMU. A maximum of 80 semester hours in music (MUSI, MUEN, MUAP, MUMI) can be counted toward a degree. ● Pending approval by the THECB.

NOTE: This is NOT a degree plan. After completing 30 hours, students are encouraged to request an official degree plan by using the online [Degree Plan Request](#) form. *Generally, a grade of "C" is required to advance to the next level of piano and theory/aural skills courses.

*MUSI 1311 + 1116; 1312 + 1117; 2311 + 2116; 2312 + 2117 are concurrent enrollment courses.

*Enrollment in core curriculum courses, which should be completed as early as possible, during intersessions and summer sessions will reduce course loads during the fall and spring semesters.
