WTAMU Experiential Education Program Summer 2011 Executive Summary

The Experiential Education program (formerly Cooperative Education) began in the spring of 1994. A Title VIII Department of Education grant started the program, and we placed the first students in the spring of 1994. Our vital statistics to date include:

- ➤ Monitored 2,017 individual placements to date (75 in Summer 2011)
- ➤ Placed 962 students in internships (unduplicated count)
- ➤ Average GPA of the Summer 2011 class 3.29
- ➤ Average wage for paid internships for the Summer 2011 class \$13.41 per hour
- > Total dollars earned by the Summer 2011 class \$376,467
- Total dollars earned by all internship students to date \$7,378,475

For the academic year to date, the Experiential Education & Career Services program helped **1,539** students through both online and in-person résumé workshops. Additionally, our counselors have provided career counseling to **255** students. This counseling and guidance helps students determine their best career path.
